

LICENCE TO COMMUNICATE

Open General Licence to Communicate (petroleum exports and petroleum products from Iraq) dated 21 May 1996 granted by the Secretary of State.

Coming into force on 21 May 1996.

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by Article 2 of the Iraq and Kuwait (United Nations Sanctions) Order 1990 (a) (“the Order”) hereby grants the following Open General Licence:

Licensed Acts

1. Subject to paragraph 2 below, this Licence authorises any act calculated to promote:

- (a) the exportation from Iraq of petroleum and petroleum products in accordance with Resolution 986 of the United Nations Security Council;
- (b) dealing in petroleum and petroleum product that have been so exported from Iraq; that is, by way of trade or otherwise for gain, acquiring or disposing of such goods or of any property or interest in them or any right to or charge upon them or processing them.

Conditions

2. Nothing in this Licence authorises the making or carrying out of any contract or the importation of any goods into the United Kingdom.

Entry into force

3. This Licence shall come into force on 21 May 1996.
