ABSTRACT

This reference book is designed to provide in-depth technical descriptions for the items in Annex 3 of the Handbook for Notifications of Exports to Iraq (United Nations Security Council Resolution 1051 — 1996). The overall format closely follows the Annex 3 format. Each subsection begins by repeating verbatim the definition of the item as given in Annex 3. The definitions are expanded by providing (1) an introductory note, (2) a description of the typical appearance of the item, (3) health and safety cautions if there are any associated with the item, (4) typical nuclear uses of the item, and (5) site-specific photos taken by inspection teams.

The book starts with the General Note from Annex 3 followed by technical description for individual items. There are four appendices : (1) Detailed Specifications for Machine Tools as Listed in Annex 3, (2) Site-Specific Maps, (3) Acronyms and Initials; and (4) Glossary.
